1. Council voted to add Approving Mayor Barger to sign ARC Grant Documents to the Agenda.
2. Council approved Minutes from August 10, 2015 Work Session.
3. Council approved Minutes from August 10, 2015 Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes.
4. Council voted to approve Jerry McBride's request to rezone from an R-2 property to a C-2 property located at Tax Map 53, Parcel 4.
5. Council voted to delay Dennis M. King's request to subdivide into two lots located at Tax Map R5, parcel 79 until he has met preliminary plat requirements.
6. Council voted to delay Dennis M. King's request for a variance of 100' min. street frontage to plus/minus 95' located at Tax Map R5, parcel 79 until he has met preliminary plat requirements.
7. Council voted to approve LJ Investments Holdings, LLC request to subdivide the property into two lots located at Tax Map 39D, Parcel 12.
8. Council voted to approve H& J Properties, Inc. request for a variance to have a gravel parking lot located at Tax Map 39B, Parcel 1 with the stipulation that the gravel does not come in contact with any public thoroughfare or sidewalk.
9. Council voted to approve the request of Naren Patel to rezone from I-1 properties to C-2 properties for future commercial development located at Tax Map 39B, Parcels 56, 57-3, 57-4 and 57-7.
10. Council approved the Paint Order for Road Striping in the amount of \$7,811.55.
11. Council voted against putting a dog park in place of the ball field located at the recreation park.
12. Council voted to have the City talk with Catoosa County and GDOT to help financially with the improvements at Chapman Road and Hwy 41 intersection and to trim back on the drainage improvements.
