2. Council approved the Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes from April 25, 2016.
3. Council voted to remove Item D Septic Tank from the Agenda pending further investigation.
4. Council voted to move the newly annexed property owned by Down South Homes, LLC rezoning request to the June 13 council meeting.
5. Council voted to approve H&K Properties, LLC request for a variance on the side setback from the required 20 feet to 10 feet. The property is located at Tax Map R2, Parcel 54.
6. Council voted to approve Steven L. Chancey and Jason P. Chancey's request to have their property rezoned from an R-1 property to a C-2 property located at Tax Map R11, Parcel 18.
7. Council voted to approve the Downtown Development Authority's request for a variance of the req'd. 50 feet street frontage to 42 feet on the Mountain Street frontage and a variance of the req'd. 50 feet street frontage to 45.71 feet on the Tennessee Street frontage located at Tax Map R6, Parcel 221.
