In late July, crews began working to improve several parking areas along Emberson Drive, including the lot at the entrance of the Chief Richard Nature Trail, the lot in front of Patriot Hall, and the gravel lot at the Ringgold Swimming Pool. These paving projects have since been completed, and visitors will now have easier access to these areas. The Martha Denton Pool also got an upgrade to its pool house with a new roof that improves fire protection for the building. Both of these projects were made possible in part by SPLOST!

## What a Feat! Creekside Is Complete.

Phase Two of the Creekside Park Project, which focuses on improving the area behind the Creekside Pickleball Courts, began in January of this year. Now, after several months of hard work, the City is thrilled to announce that the project will be officially completed on August 13th! Funds collected through the Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax helped finance the Creekside Project, which provides visitors with five new soccer fields, new restrooms, an outdoor stage, additional sidewalks, and more green spaces. The City of Ringgold will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony at Creekside (date TBA), and we invite our community to attend and explore the park!
