Ringgold's Water Revamp Grucial Water Line Replaced for Residents

If you've noticed recent construction on Highway 41, you're watching Ringgold get a new and improved water supply! 90% of City residents receive their water from a single line running from the Water Plant to Peters Lane, and this line was installed over half a century ago. Now that it has reached the end of its life, the Mayor and Council approved a critical replacement of the line, which is scheduled to be finished in August. The City received a \$3.7 million loan, with \$3.3 million of this loan receiving principal forgiveness, which dramatically reduces the project's dependence on user fees.
